

DIRECTIONS TO HUMBER COLLEGE

Lakeshore Campus

Located just west of Toronto on the shore of Lake Ontario, the Lakeshore campus offers beautiful historic architecture, modern conveniences and lots of ways to connect with nature.

Major intersection: Gardiner Expressway and Kipling Avenue. Go south on Kipling to the Lakeshore Boulevard West. Turn right (west) onto Lakeshore Boulevard West. Turn left (south) onto 23rd Street.

Parking: The Humber College Parking Lot will be on your left. A Humber retiree will be at the kiosk to greet you. (Ignore parking lot signs which say "Permit Parking only".) A Humber retiree will guide you to the **Humber Lakeshore Commons** building (5 minute walk) where the meeting will be held. The **OCRA General Meeting is in Room # L1017.**

Public Transportation: From Bloor-Danforth ② line, Kipling Station: take bus 188 or 44 —; or from Yonge-University ① line, Queen or Osgoode Station: take bus 501 — to Colonel Samuel Smith Drive and walk south to **Humber Lakeshore Commons** building.

People will be at the parking kiosk; at the walkway and at the building to direct participants to **Humber Lakeshore Commons** building.
