Major intersection:

Lakeshore Blvd and Kipling Avenue

Parking: Go south on Kipling to Lakeshore Blvd. West. Turn right (west) onto Lakeshore Blvd. West. Very shortly **Turn left (south) onto Twenty Third Street – Parking Lot 1 is on your left: GPS: 72 Twenty Third St, Etobicoke, ON M8V 3N2**

Please bring the one-day Parking Permit which we will provide after you Register for the GM - for the day's free parking. PLEASE DISPLAY the PARKING PERMIT CLEARLY ON YOUR DASHBOARD after you Park.
