Annual membership \$10.00 CAD, renewable at the beginning of each calendar year.

Surviving spouse membership \$10.00 CAD, renewable at the beginning of each calendar year for the spouse of a deceased member wishing to continue his/her membership. On request, the lifetime membership of a deceased member is transferable to the surviving spouse.

Lifetime membership (refer to fee table below). Annual members may convert to the lifetime membership at renewal time. The OCRA Lifetime Membership is for the lifetime of the individual and is not refundable.
